What is Curriculum?

Curriculum refers to the lessons and academic content taught in a school or in a specific course or program.

Curriculum is the framework that teachers use to plan instruction for their students.

Curriculum (or curricula) is defined broadly to include four basic components:

1. **Goals:** The benchmarks or expectations for teaching and learning, often made explicit in the form of a scope and sequence of skills to be addressed;
2. **Methods:** The specific instructional methods for the teacher, often described in a teacher's edition; (*content vs. process*)
3. **Materials:** The media and tools that are used for teaching and learning;
4. **Assessment:** The reasons for and methods of measuring student progress.

What is Assessment?

Assessment refers a variety of methods or tools that educators use to measure academic readiness, learning progress, or educational needs of students.

Types of Assessment:

Formative- to inform teaching and learning while it's happening

Summative- to evaluate learning/progress at the conclusion of an instructional period



Professional Development

PD Vendor guide identifies vendors who specialize in helping districts and schools with each stage of designing and implementing a cohesive academic system.

STEP 1: Introductory district-wide curriculum/assessment training

Provide pre-service PD for teachers that builds their familiarity with the structure, approach, and key components of high-quality curricula and assessments.

STEP 2: School-based curriculum training

Build teachers' ability to use their high-quality curricula and assessments.

STEP 3: On-going curriculum-focused coaching

Deepen teachers' knowledge of content and content pedagogy, build teachers' skill in using student data to meet the needs of all learners, and foster teacher leadership and collaboration.
